Conference. Shan Sa is a prominent Francophone novelist, born in China in 1972. At only seven years old she decided to devote herself to writing and five years later, she won First Price at the **National Children Poetry Contest** in China.

Terrified by the events of Tian An Men in 1989, she left her country for Paris.

There she studied philosophy, published six novels in French and won the Prix Goncourt gaining critical acclaim worldwide. Two of her novels have been translated into English and are the subject of major movie productions.
