National Water Activities Weekend – Venture Scouts

Overview

1. Camping weekend with Water Activities in Liliput Adventure Centre, Mullingar, Co. Westmeath from Friday 30th June 1800hrs – Sunday 2nd July 1400hrs
2. Activities will include Rafting, Kayaking, Canoeing, Sailing and more.
3. Check in and setup camp anytime between 1800 and 2000 on Friday.
4. Leaders are responsible for their own Groups at all times (Leaders must be in possession of consent forms at check-in)
5. Programme will be supplied for the weekend. Scouting through Water Activities. Water Activities bases will be positioned in and around Liliput Adventure Centre.
6. Evening programme
7. At least one leader must remain on-site at all times with each group.
8. Scout Groups must provide their own **camping equipment and all food.** Site will be allocated on arrival. No specification for site set up whatever is most convenient and comfortable for your group. There will be a facility for freezing freezer blocks if required.

Registration & Fees

3. The cost of the weekend is **€ 75.00 per participant**, the fee includes
 - a. Programme Material for the Weekend
 - b. Camping Fees
 - c. Event Badge for each participant
 - d. Each group will get a framed participation certificate with group photograph
4. **The booking deposit for participants is € 30 non-refundable, required by 28th April 2006**
