'DO NOT BE AFRAID, JUST HAVE FAITH'

This episode begins with Jesus crossing the Sea of Galilee 'to the other side.' It is here that Jairus meets him with the news of his daughter's sickness and his request that Jesus heal her.

'Crossing to the other side' can imply passage over frightening depths or fearful distances from sin to repentance, from faithfulness to trust, from sickness to health, from death to life. Jairus asks Jesus to see his daughter safely to the other side of her sickness. But then comes the report that she has died. 'Why trouble the teacher any longer?' Discouragement and fear - not doubt - are the opposites of biblical faith and can stop our progress from where we are to where we need to be.

'Do not be afraid; just have faith,' says Jesus, reminding Jairus that the other side is not far away, that the girl is only asleep. The mourners laugh at the idea, but Jesus takes her hand and leads her to safety.

Later Jesus himself will cross to the other side of death, accompanied only by his trust in his Father's will.

When have I experienced a crossing from discouragement to faith? Can I continue to trust that Jesus will make the crossing with me?
