ARAS ATTRACTA SWIMMING POOL: Mayo County Council with the good will of the Health Service Executive are pleased to announce that there will be limited public sessions available in the Aras Attracta Swimming Pool, Swinford commencing on 11^{th} August on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays. The hours of open sessions will be **7.00 to 7.50 p.m.** / **8.00 to 8.50 p.m. and 9.00 to 9.50 p.m.** Prices are \notin 4 per Adult and \notin 2.50 per child. The numbers at the pool are restricted too between 16 and 20 people per session. Please note that bookings can only be made on the day preceeding or on the day of the session you require. This is a pilot project which will require community support.
