#### 'UNTIE HIM AND LET HIM GO'

Why didn't Jesus loosen Lazarus' funeral wrappings himself? Because that's our job. The Christian Community is charged with the task of freeing fellow believers to live the life Jesus has given us.

When Jesus tells Martha he is the resurrection and the life, he is saying we don't have to wait for resurrection at the end of life on earth (heaven as normally perceived). We already have life through Baptism and Faith. Notice Jesus says, 'I am the Resurrection and the Life.' It is his job to give us new life now, but it is our job to help free one another to live it.Lazarus was alive, but he couldn't move properly until someone unwrapped him. We're alive in Christ, too, but are not always free because of fears, doubts, depression or loss. We need a loving hand to untie us and help us to move freely about in the risen life of Christ. Jesus wants us to have 'Life to the full' and bestows it freely, but our personal issues often keep us from experiencing this gift. When we love one another as Jesus has loved us, the wrappings of death loosen and fall and, like Lazarus, we are free.
