THE MYSTERY OF GOD'S LOVE.

As an account of human suffering, the passion story of Jesus has lost much of its impact on the human heart. Recent decades have brought us face to face with accounts and pictures of unbounded human cruelty and suffering. The savagery of war is rivalled only by the violence of crime in a spiral of destruction that endangers our world. Pitted over against the visual and emotional impact of such horrendous events, the mere repetition of the story of the sufferings and death of Jesus in today's gospel can pale into insignificance and degenerate into boredom. But, to be bored with the passion story because of its mildness is to miss the point. The core of the story is not to highlight the cruelty of the Jews and the Romans, severe though it be, but rather to recall in faith who suffered and why he went through it all, not only freely but with a sense of genuine fulfilment.

Love was his motive. Love is always a mystery and God's love more so than any other. While we can never fully understand such total self-giving, we can grow in appreciation and begin to imitate it. That is the opportunity of passion time, to allow our coarsened hearts to be touched again by the overwhelming love of Jesus Christ. In busy and distracted lives, it is important to make time for such a change of heart. To fail to do so is to live unenriched by the most stupendous reality this world has ever known.

Altar Servers are asked to arrive at the Church a little earlier than usual to become more familiar with the ceremonies for Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday. If you are unable to attend the ceremony you are named for, you are asked to get another Server to replace you.

PALM SUNDAY is this Sunday 16th March. If the weather is suitable we are assembling at Killasser Community Centre before the Vigil Mass this Saturday evening at 7.45 p.m. approx to bless the Palm Branches and then move in procession to the Church for Mass. At Callow Church on Sunday morning you are invited to assemble at 9.45 a.m. at the entrance on the Swinford side of the Church for the blessing of Palm and then process into the Church. This is a more meaningful way of celebrating this special occasion and more in keeping with what happened on the first Palm Sunday. For those unable to walk this distance, Palm Branches will be available inside both churches.

HOLY THURSDAY - MASS OF THE LORD'S SUPPER IN KILLASSER CHURCH: Hopefully, like other years, we can have a meaningful Offertory Procession which will involve a number of people. At Mass on Holy Thursday everybody will have the opportunity to receive Holy Communion under both species

HOLY THURSDAY IN CALLOW CHURCH: Mass of the Lord's Supper will be at 7 p.m. An Offertory Procession will be part of the Liturgy. At least six people are needed to bring up gifts, so we are asking for volunteers.

<u>GOOD FRIDAY - CELEBRATION OF THE LORD'S PASSION IN KILLASSER CHURCH</u> will be celebrated in the traditional way at 3.00 p.m. People from all areas of the Parish and beyond are more than welcome to attend.

GOOD FRIDAY - A MEDITATION AROUND THE CROSS IN CALLOW CHURCH will be celebrated in Callow Church on Good Friday Evening, commencing at 8.00 p.m. We are confident that you will find this ceremony meaningful as it has been over the past few years. Many people will be needed to participate in the ceremony, so hopefully, anybody willing to be involved will be able to come along to a practice on this Sunday evening at 6.00 p.m. People from all over the Parish and beyond are most welcome to attend on Friday Evening.
