There is no one more persistent than a parent pleading for the recovery of the health and safety of his or her child. Only one: I will love him so much, will bear with him so patiently, I will forgive him so often that the day will come when he will love me as I will love him.'

Jesus on the cross, is the ultimate manifestation of God's love for us; he is willing to risk our rejection.

We are called to reflect the same unselfish love for others.

'Am I willing to risk rejection when I serve others and when I ask for the things that I need?'
