GOD'S WORD - LISTEN UP.

In any project, it is important to be clear about the mission at hand, to focus on it and live it and not lose sight of it. And there is so much to distract us in the modern world. We have never had so much media saturation before. Information is available constantly. But too much exposure to noise deafens. Maybe that is what has happened to us in relation to the Word of God.

When you look at that Ezra's people of the First Reading, the ancient, uneducated, simple folk, who could not even imagine a T.V. or a computer, seem to be far more aware of the fact they are hearing the words of the Creator, than their modern counterparts. Unlike a modern congregation who sit in beefy calm, they actually react and respond to what they hear.

So. What's changed? We live in constant haste, noise and fear. We are bombarded by an enormous amount of relevant and irrelevant information, countless images of poverty and opulence, violence and helplessness.

We become unable to hear because we hear so much and the tune keeps changing constantly. The tragedy lies in our growing inability to distinguish between the voices - in effect, the voice of God is drowned in the chatter of a monkey.

He doesn't look for much, an open ear and heart, a willingness to hear and act in His name. So that 'this text is being fulfilled today even as you listen.'
