#### 'YOU ARE PETER'

Peter's name in Aramaic and in Greek means 'rock', leading many to shake their heads at the irony. Didn't Peter at one time fall into the water as he tried to walk towards Jesus? Isn't this the man who impetuously prepared to set up tents after the Transfiguration, never to return to reality again? And isn't he the one who will warm himself by a fire, denying his knowledge of Jesus during the crucifixion? Yes to all of the above, but Jesus saw in him a solid and enduring faith, even if it was imperfect.

Names are a very essential part of our identities. They can help to distinguish us from others, or tie us to ancestors who shared the same name and can even contain a meaning that helps to describe who we are called to be. When our names are spoken at baptism, we are claiming and recognising our God-given identity.

When I was growing up there was a popular song with the line, 'I heard the Lord call my name. Listen close, you'll hear the same.' I think if we listen closely we will hear the Lord call our name just as he called Peter's name, and Paul's, and all those saints who have gone before us.
