## LIVING STONES.

'The beauty of the world has made me sad, this beauty that will pass', wrote Patrick Pearse. The word of Jesus today are about a world that will pass. Should they focus our attention on his second coming, or on the destruction of the beautiful temple, or on the end of the world? They have a bearing on all three. But they contain no secret time code. Jesus wasn't given to answering question about when. Instead he told us about how we are to be now if we are to be ready for then.

We get reminders of the passing of the world in the continual recurring of each of the disasters named by Jesus and in such new realities as the tsunami and the Twin Towers calamity. Each of these makes us sad, even frightened. But the assured presence of Jesus himself makes every sadness bearable. He keeps asking us to take care, to endure, to bear witness, not to be unduly frightened.

The temple that will last is Christ's body. Each of us is called to be a living stone of that temple, an active member of the body given for the life of the world.
