EUCHARIST IS LIFE-GIVING.

A woman tells this story about the birth of her first child. Her prevailing thought waiting in the hospital was, 'I don't mind what happens to me, as long as the baby is alright.' And indeed, everything went fine. It was near the weekend when the baby was born and on Sunday she felt well enough to go to Mass in the hospital chapel.

As she describes it, she felt herself filling up with a blaze of light when she heard the words of consecration, as if for the first time. 'This is my body given up for you This is my blood shed for you.' She exclaimed to herself, 'Jesus, I know what you mean!' Mass was never the same again.

Countless mothers have heard the words of consecration in the same way. In this they have glimpsed the profound connection between God's self-giving and ours. We are not meant to look on at the consecration like spectators at a show. We are meant to bring to it our own story of self-giving - the pain of letting go and giving ourselves to another; the joy of knowing that we have given new life to another person.

There is so much giving of self going on in our lives. It may not be as dramatic as a mother giving birth but it is no less amazing for that. Think of how children give so much life to others. Think of how generous friends can be in times of need. Think of how people who are suffering grace the lives of those around them.

If we bring to the Eucharist this awareness of our own self-giving, it helps us get in touch with what the consecration means. If we tune in to our own striving to live for others, we are able to appreciate more of the incredible self-giving of God. This moment of adoration becomes more precious when we bring to it a sense of wonder at who we are ourselves. Then we can pray to God; 'May Christ make us an everlasting gift to you.'

For Reflection: *'Think of Jesus as life-giving for you,* And of yourself as life-giving for others.'
