
From Ballinalee

- Take the Edgeworthstown Road
- Follow this road for approx. 3½ miles, careful of the bad bends, until you see a derelict house on the left watch for the 'blind' right hand bend
- Turn left at this junction following the sign post for Granard
- The stone wall entrance is on the left hand side
- Follow the avenue to the car park

- The stone wall entrance is on the left hand side
- Follow the avenue to the car park
